

Larry's Lines....

He Who Conquers

"He who conquers shall have this heritage, and I will be his God and he shall be my son" (Revelation 21:7)

"To the victors belong the spoils," said Andrew Jackson. It's always been that way in warfare. And awaiting the conquering Sons of God is a glorious heritage. Ray Summers has described it as: Fellowship with God; Protection by God; and Provisions from God.

- Fellowship with God (Revelation 21:1-8)** The Seer fastens his eyes upon the new heaven and the new earth and announces, "Behold, the dwelling of God is with men." The word used for dwelling meant literally and initially a tent. It was the word which was used for the Tabernacle in the Old Testament. God had promised His people of old, *"I will set my tabernacle among you and I will walk among you, and will be your God, and ye shall be my people (Leviticus 26:11,12).* Can you imagine a higher promise than intimate fellowship with God? God will look upon His people and "he will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be a mourning nor crying nor pain any more, for the former things have passed away." To abide with God throughout eternity is the heritage of the conqueror.
- Protection by God (Revelation 21:9-26).** The treasures of language and imagination are exhausted in presenting The City of God. And around this city is a great wall. The ancients would immediately understand that this symbolized protection. In the words of Isaiah, *"We have a strong city; salvation will God appoint for wall and bulwarks" (Isaiah 26:1).* Summers observes, "The entire description is intended to present a strong, spacious, perfect, and beautiful city where God's redeemed will dwell with him in perfect fellowship." Behind the walls, and in the city, the saints of God rest secure.
- Provisions from God (Revelation 22:1-5).** The victors are assured of water, food and health. There is "the river of the water of life, bright as crystal, flowing from the throne of God." William Barclay writes, "Those who live in a civilization in which the turn of a tap will bring cold, clear water to any house in any quantity can scarcely understand how precious water was in the East. In the East, in the dry deserts and the hot lands, water was, and is, quite literally life." In addition there is the tree of life which furnishes men with varied fruits, and brings forth its yield each month. And health is made sure, because "the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations. Victory is ahead! And all things follow victory.

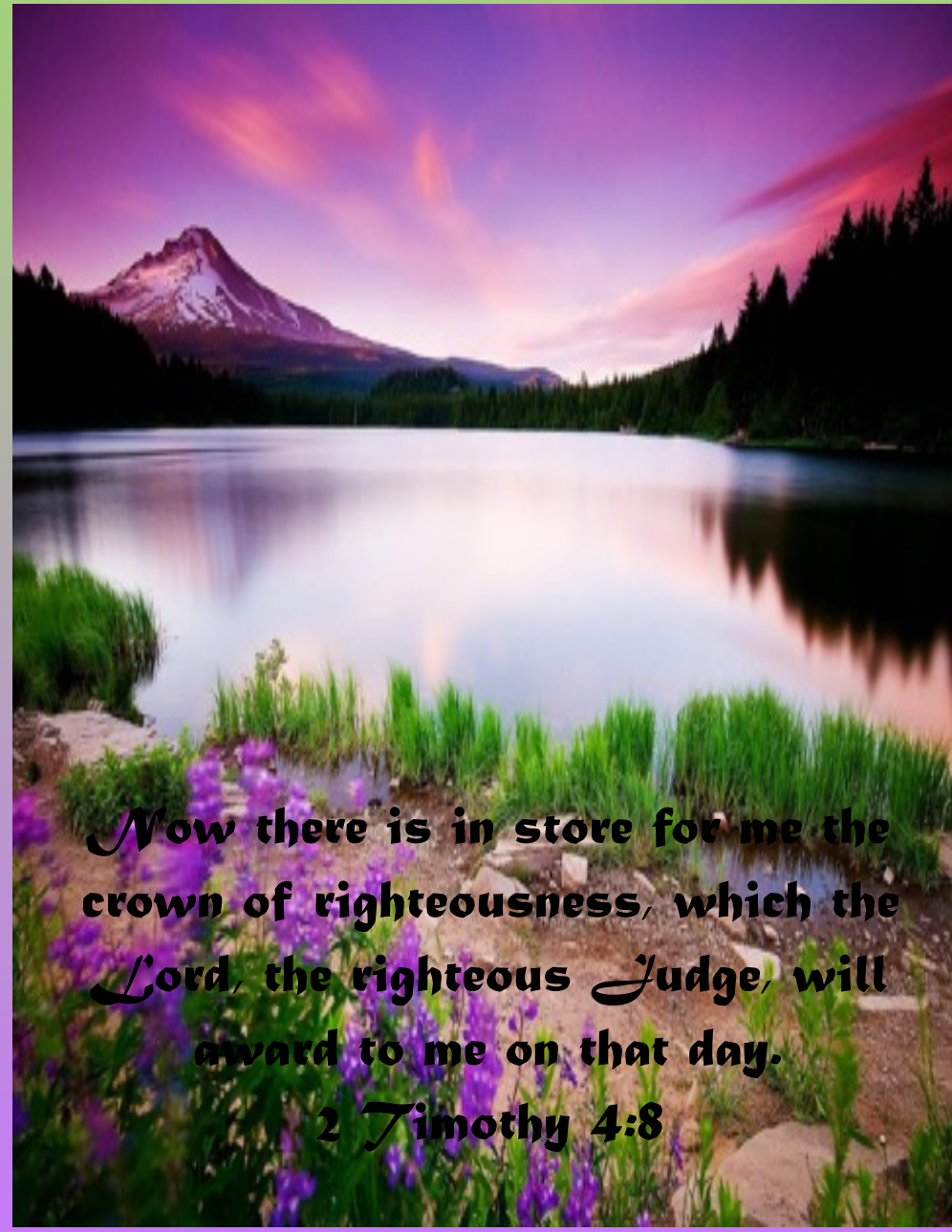
