Fíre From Heaven

Early in their careers James and John were called "the sons of thunder." They were willing to destroy anybody that was not willing to receive Jesus. Luke tells us about the time that Jesus was going to Jerusalem and sought to enter a village of the Samarítans along the way. The Master had sent messengers ahead of him to prepare everything, but the people would not receive him. James and John saw what was going on and said, "Lord, do you want us to bid fire come down from Heaven and consume them?" How shocked they must have been when Jesus turned and rebuked them for wanting to fry these Samaritans to a crísp. $(Luke 9:51-56)^{-1}$

These brothers thought they had the perfect right to be angry. Who did these Samaritans think they were? They were a mongrel race having sprung from the heathen Assyrians. It was a shame even to have them in this land where they had married degenerate Israelites unworthy of the name. They were blasphemous heretics who only accepted the first five books of the Old Testament. They worshiped at Gerizim instead of Jerusalem. Why not launch all of the thunder and fire one could get from heaven against such unworthy people?

But no! Jesus would not have it. He lost little time in rebuking this monstrous proposal. The mission of Jesus was not to destroy men but to save them. The zeal of James and John was not pure. It was mixed up with bitter carnal passions, anger, pride and self-will. They had been chosen to preach a message of mercy to every creature, but they were perfectly willing to destroy the very creatures they were called to preach to.

What a world of difference there was between Jesus and his dísciples on this occasion.

It's an old story, you say. Well, maybe not. I wonder how many times those of us who call ourselves disciples, and under the guise of a zeal for God, have acted more like James and John, than Jesus?
