But Nehemiah answered, "I am doing a great work and I cannot come down. Why should the work stop while I leave it and come down to you?" And even though the offer was made four times, it was answered in the same manner each time. Finally, the vile art of slander was practiced. False letters were written and taken into the city by a prophet who had been bribed. It was stated that Nehemiah was fomenting a rebellion and was planning to make himself an independent king. Such lies where cooly calculated to remove a man's head from the rest of his body. Calmly Nehemiah answered, "No such things as you say has been done, for you are inventing them out of your own mind." "For they all wanted to frighten us in our thinking" said Nehemiah. "Their hands will drop from the work, and it will not be done." Brother, were they fooled? This great prophet knew how to deal with his enemies and still accomplish his work.


