These are your only possessions as you set out with your boy to wander in the wilderness of Beersheba. As far as the eve can see, the weird waste stretches in monotonous ugliness and the low winds are blowing the sand. After several days the provisions play out. The desert tortures with thirst and threatens to become an untimely grave. You cast your son under one of the little bushes and then move some distance from him as you pray, "Let me not look upon the death of the child." The anguish is intense.
