Does Prayer Work

I am convinced that there are times when even the prayers of the most righteous won't "work." The Bible says so. The Lord told Jeremiah, "Though Moses and Samuel stood before me, yet my heart would not turn toward this people" (Jeremiah 15:1) Now Moses and Samuel were two as great a favorites of heaven as you are likely to meet. And both of them are particularly famed for the success of their mediation between God and his offending people. On more than one occasion they saved the lives of their people through prayer. But there are times when no human intervention is of any avail, and we need to recognize that fact.

Even the prayer of Jesus Christ failed to "work" as it concerned his escape from the Cross. But he didn't stop believing in prayer. In fact, he still prayed while he was hanging upon the cross.

In every prayer there should be the sentiment, whether verbalized or not. "Thy will be done."


