We all should be thankful for the fear of pain which led to the discovery of anesthetics? The list could go on and on. But unhappily however, fear does not always keep to a beneficial role. The wrong kind of fear (as the Bible says) has torment. It over reaches itself, and people are tortured by it.

Mark 4:35-41 introduces us to an experience with which we can identify. We all find ourselves sitting with the disciples in that little boat. We too, have seen the waves beating against the ship of life; we have felt the sting of the wind and rain; and we have rowed on an uncertain sea. And like the disciples of old we need to hear the questions Jesus asked them, "Why are you afraid? Have you no faith?"

When we look at the eventful life of Christ with all its difficulties we still see a man who lived free of every foolish fear. He had such complete trust in the Father's love and power that He would go on without the paralyzing effects of fear.

Perhaps the words of Robert H. Burrows would be helpful to many of us who struggle with fears.

"Fear not, 'tis I," how calm the Savior's words
Accompanied by His mighty power to save.*

*"Fear not" God's message still to you and me.
