## Larry's Lines.. <br> WHY GO TO CHURCH?

In the long ago God ordained that there should be two silver trumpets with differing sounds. Why? In order that his people might be called together for solemn assemblies (Numbers 10:2-3). God evidently saw some value in all of the people coming together. Most responded in the spirit of the psalmist, " was glad when they said unto me, Let us go into the house of the Lord" (Psalm 122:1). It was not a matter of "have to" but "want to." They came in expectancy and departed with a blessing.
Nor were things different with the early Christians we meet on the pages of the New Testament. Christian fellowship was an extraordinarily vital and impressive thing. Men and women from all ranks of life met together, saluted one another and praised God. In their assemblies you might find Saul of Tarsus, a former leader of the Pharisees; Luke, the beloved physician; slaves from the Greek slums; barbarians; former harlots and tax collectors: or even members of Caesar's own household. Only one thing could explain that-CHRIST. By one spirit they had been baptized into one body (1 Corinthians 12:13). They were no longer Jews or Gentiles, bond or free. They were brothers and sisters in Christ.....and members of a family that loved to be together.

Apparently all of them found something in the assembly, for they were constantly coming together. Of the church in Jerusalem we read, "all that believed were together"(Acts 2:44). When the persecution arose, the church "assembled together" for prayer (Acts 4:31). On the first day of the week they "came together" to break bread (Acts 20:7). The whole church "met together" for teaching and edifying (1 Corinthians $14: 23,26$ ). They were together, together, together.

Besides the fellowship of kindred minds, the Christians sought the presence of Christ-. They believed the promise of Jesus, "For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there I am in the midst of them." (Matthew 18:20)

Assembling together with the saints for worship and fellowship should play a vital role in every Christian's life. Knowledge is increased, character is developed, zeal is stimulated, and conduct altered. Someone once described Sunday as "an oasis in the desert of this noisy, hectic, rushing weekday life." It is that. ..but it's a great deal more. Forsake not the assembling of yourselves together. (Hebrews 10:25)
