## THE RICHES OF GOD'S BOUNTY

Charles Spurgeon tells of how he once laughed when preparing a sermon. He said it was the only time he ever remembered laughing in such serious business. He was going to preach on Joseph. He had drawn a picture of the colossal stores of corn in Egypt, the granaries bursting with abundance. There was a supply of corn for seven years.

And then in the midst of his vivid conception, Spurgeon saw a little mouse in one corner of a granary worrying itself to death in fear that there wasn't enough to live on.

Do not worry! That's the message of Jesus. Don't worry about your life. Don't worry about what you will eat or drink. Don't worry about your body, what you will wear. Look at the birds. Your heavenly Father feeds them. Yet you are much more valuable than they.

"Therefore do not be anxious, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' For the Gentiles seek all these things; and your heavenly Father knows that you need them all. But seek his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things shall be yours as well. Therefore do not be anxious about tomorrow, for tomorrow will be anxious for itself. Let the day's own trouble be sufficient for the day" (Matthew 6:31-34).

1. V.31 "If God be for us, who can be against us?"
2. V.33 "Who shall bring any charge against God's elect?"
3. V.34 "It is God who justifies. Who is to condemn?"
4. V.35 "Who shall separate us from the love of God?"

THE ANSWER: "NO ONE"

THAT'S OUR BLESSED ASSURANCE!

How do we know that? How can we be sure that we are never defeated or never separated from God?

1. Because God gave up His own Son for us. V32
2. Because God is the One who justifies us. V.33
3. Because Jesus is interceding for us. V.34
4. Because we are more than Conquerors. V37
