What Do You Expect in Worship

It's Sunday. You have made your way to the assembly of the saints. You enter the door, find a seat, and wait for the service to begin. Is this just going to be a way of killing an hour, or would something more important happen? Geoffrey Wainwright in his book Doxology has given me food for thought by listing eight "attitudes" which typically occur in Christian worship.

- 1. Adoration: There is the acknowledgement of God's transcendence. Our response is: "Come let us worship and bow down, let us kneel before the Lord our Maker" (Psalm 95:6).
- Confession of sin: How can we be in the presence of the Holy One without acknowledging our failed potential and missed opportunities? There should be penitence in our hearts and the confession of sin upon our lips.
- <u>Proclamation and thanksgiving.</u> The address of proclamation is to the world; the address of thanksgiving is to God. Yet these things are closely related because proclamation and thanksgiving typically recite the mighty acts of God on behalf of humanity and His benefits bestowed on us.
- Commitment: We are offering ourselves to God in obedience for His service.
- Intercession: God's commitment to the world is shown by His very creation of it, by His continuing preservation of it, and by His redemption of it through Jesus Christ. But human intercessions are addressed to God from within our hearts, pleading with God to have mercy on our souls.
- Expectation: "I will lift up my eyes..." (Psalm 121:1). When the believer looks to God he is excepting help.
- Absence: The sense of God's absence implies a relationship. This leads toward a search for God and a positive response to His call. God is never really absent from a creation which he never ceases to love.
- Wrestling: Human wrestling with God in prayer. Remember Jacob's night-long wrestling at Penuel (Genesis 32).

I hope we will examine ourselves today and see how many of these eight "attitudes" we find present as we worship. To properly worship God we must prepare our hearts to do so. This means putting aside the cares and concerns of the world to focus our thoughts on God. It also means that we will make every effort to be on time for the start of our worship service. We must likewise remember that when the congregation is called to order at the start of our service, we should cease our visiting with one another and focus our thoughts on our purpose for assembling together-TO HONOR AND WORSHIP GOD.


