PEACE

The craving for peace is one of the oldest dreams of mankind, an unfading aspiration, of every generation. You can sense the undying hope in almost every breast. A time when: They shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruning hooks; nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more (Isa. 2:4).

A time when:

The wolf dwells with the lamb. and the leopard shall lie down with the kid, and the calf and the lion and the fatling together, and a little child shall lead them (Isa. 11:6).

Longfellow longed for a time when it could be said:

Peace! and no longer from its brazen portals The blast of War's great organ shakes the skies! But beautiful as songs of the immortals, The holy melodies of love arise.

Few things could be worse than a missed opportunity for peace. It was this which was on the mind of Jesus as he surveyed the beloved city of Jerusalem (a city which has 'peace' as part of its meaning; see (Heb. 7:2).

And when he drew near and saw the city he wept over it, saying, "Would that even today you knew the things that make for peace! But now they are hid from your eyes" (Lk. 19:41,42).

Leon Morris comments, "Especially important in the Hebrew understanding of peace (which carries over into the New Testament) is its emphasis on peace with God, right relationship between the creature and the Creator, as a necessary ingredient in true peace. It was this that the people of Jerusalem had failed to realize. And their failure to get to grips with the message of God was not final. These things, Jesus say, are hid from your eyes."

The Jerusalemites did not know the things that make for peace. Do we? We will never find them if we do not know the Prince of Peace.


