Clovis Chappell writes, "In the old steamboat days I am told that two boats belonging to rival companies left New Orleans for Memphis about the same time. Soon after leaving they began to race. One boat was loaded with a cargo of hams. When the race was very close, the captain ordered the fireman to put in two or three hams in hope of getting up more steam. It worked. Therefore more hams we're fed into the fire and at last the boat steamed ahead and won the race, but it burned up its cargo on the way. That is, in the process of making the voyage, the captain of this boat burned up the purpose of the voyage. He majored in minors. So do we, when in the process of living, we burn up the purpose of living."
