Learn To Do Good

Many things have to be learned. And Isaiah knew that even the art of "doing good" was a learned process. To become a master one must practice. If you would "learn to do good." then:

- Seek Judgement:** Christians, of all people, should be solicitous for all members of society. Justice is needful for all or it is not justice. Let the Christian "seek" that they may have their rights. In the words of the great Magna Carta, "To none will we sell, to none deny or delay, right or justice." And Amos of old pleads, "Let judgement run down as water." (Amos 5:24)
- Correct Oppression:** When men are mistreated we cannot "do good" and be casual or indifferent to their plight. John Brown, the American abolitionist, was convicted of treason and hanged December 2, 1859. He said, "I pity the poor in bondage that have none to help them; that is why I am here; not to gratify any personal animosity, revenge, or vindictive spirit. It is my sympathy with the oppressed and wronged that are as good as you, and as precious in the sight of God."
- Defend the Fatherless:** Be the champion of the orphan, See that he is not wronged. How does one execute justice for the fatherless? One of God's prophets answers that, "by giving him food and clothing." (Isaiah 10:19)
- Plead for the Widow:** Lean toward her. Speak for her. Become her advocate in court. "Honor widows that are widows indeed." (1 Timothy 5:3)

There is much to learn about "doing good" and so little time to learn it, shouldn't we get on with the job?
