But did you notice the phrase, "While the earth remains?" There's a warning in that. This earth which looks permanent is not going to be here always. "The heavens will pass away with a loud noise and the elements will be dissolved with fire and the earth and the works that are upon it will be burned up" (2 Peter 3:10). One day it will be the "late, great planet earth."

But back to our text. God kept His word about the seasons. Sometimes there are extremes in the weather but the order remains. God has been faithful to His word that even unbelievers have come to accept it as "Law". We plant in the spring and wait. We trust the seasons and act in faith. What if someone said, "I don't believe fall will come this year. I believe it will be always summer." Just mark it down; he will be the loser for his lack of faith. Whether he believes or not, it's going to be.

God is faithful. You can trust His word about the seasons...OR ANYTHING ELSE?
