WHEN THE FAMILY MOVES

Unlike many of our forefathers, most of us do not live in the same house all our lives. We move from house to house and from city to city. We are constantly being called upon to make choices. Shall the new job be accepted or turned down with its offer of higher pay, better living conditions and future advancement?

Be careful in your decision. The short range view can be suicidal. Take the case of Lot, for example. When he had his falling out with Abram he was given the privilege of moving in any direction he desired with Abram going the opposite way. Lot cast his eye toward Jordan. Shouldn't he choose prosperity? Wouldn't a man be a fool to make any other decision? The plains of Jordan was much like the garden of Eden. It was well-watered everywhere, a land of fertility, beauty and promise. The other side of the coin would mean selecting the bleak Judaean hills, countless hours of drudgery in making his living. So quick as a flash, the decision was made. He would move to the plains of Jordan. He would cast his tent toward Sodom.

Do you suppose Lot would have made the same choice if he had known that he would have bad neighbors? The inhabitants of Sodom, where known for their great wickedness. And while it may not be possible or desirable to avoid contact with the wicked, there are some great dangers involved. Meeting and marrying into families of the ungodly brought Lot more sorrow than he dreamed.

Do you suppose Lot would have made the same choice if he had known the moral deterioration which would follow the move? Before long he lost power over his own children and lived to see the day when they mocked him.

Do you suppose Lot would have made the same choice if he had known what anguish would fill his life from day to day? His soul was grieved by the sights he was forced to behold in Sodom. A sink-hole of sin is no place for a saint. Obviously Lot had considered material prosperity but had not weighed the moral hazards.

When you get ready to make your next move, remember the danger of judging things only by their outward appearance. All that glitters is not gold. Jesus is still asking: "WHAT SHALL IT PROFIT A MAN IF HE GAINS THE WHOLE WORLD AND LOSE HIS OWN SOUL?"
