The Third Day

Paul was certain. Christ had been raised from the dead. It was no phantom that had come into the upper room, or talked with the disciples on the road to Damascus, or came to the shores of the Sea of Galilee. While these things had happened to others, Paul certainly did not doubt them because the Lord had actually appeared to him! And that appearance changed the whole course of his life.

Paul reminded the Corinthians that the death and the resurrection of Christ was according to the scriptures. "For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received, that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the scriptures" (1 Corinthians 15:3-4). It happened just as the holy scriptures had testified. That should convince God fearing people.

Paul recounted the appearance to Cephas, then to the twelve, but he does not stop there. "Then he appeared to more than five hundred brethren at one time, most of whom are still alive, though some have fallen asleep" (1 Corinthians 15:6). At the time Paul wrote this, there were more than two hundred and fifty persons still living who had seen the savior at least on one occasion after His rising from the dead. Now here was an assertion which the Corinthians might, if they wanted to, verify for themselves. They could actually pay a visit to some of the two hundred and fifty, and cross examine them. Obviously, Paul was not one bit concerned about presenting such a challenge. He was sure of his ground. He planted his foot upon the rock of experience; his own, and the experience of others.

In the ringing words of Paul, he declares, "But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep" (1 Corinthians 15:20). In Christ is a "power" which death cannot extinguish. Our hope lies in that.

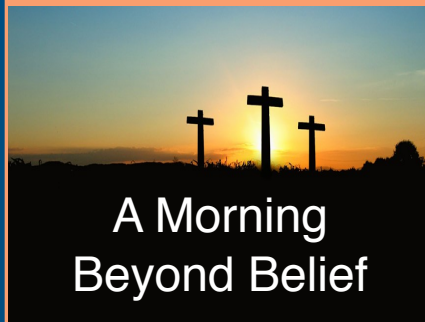

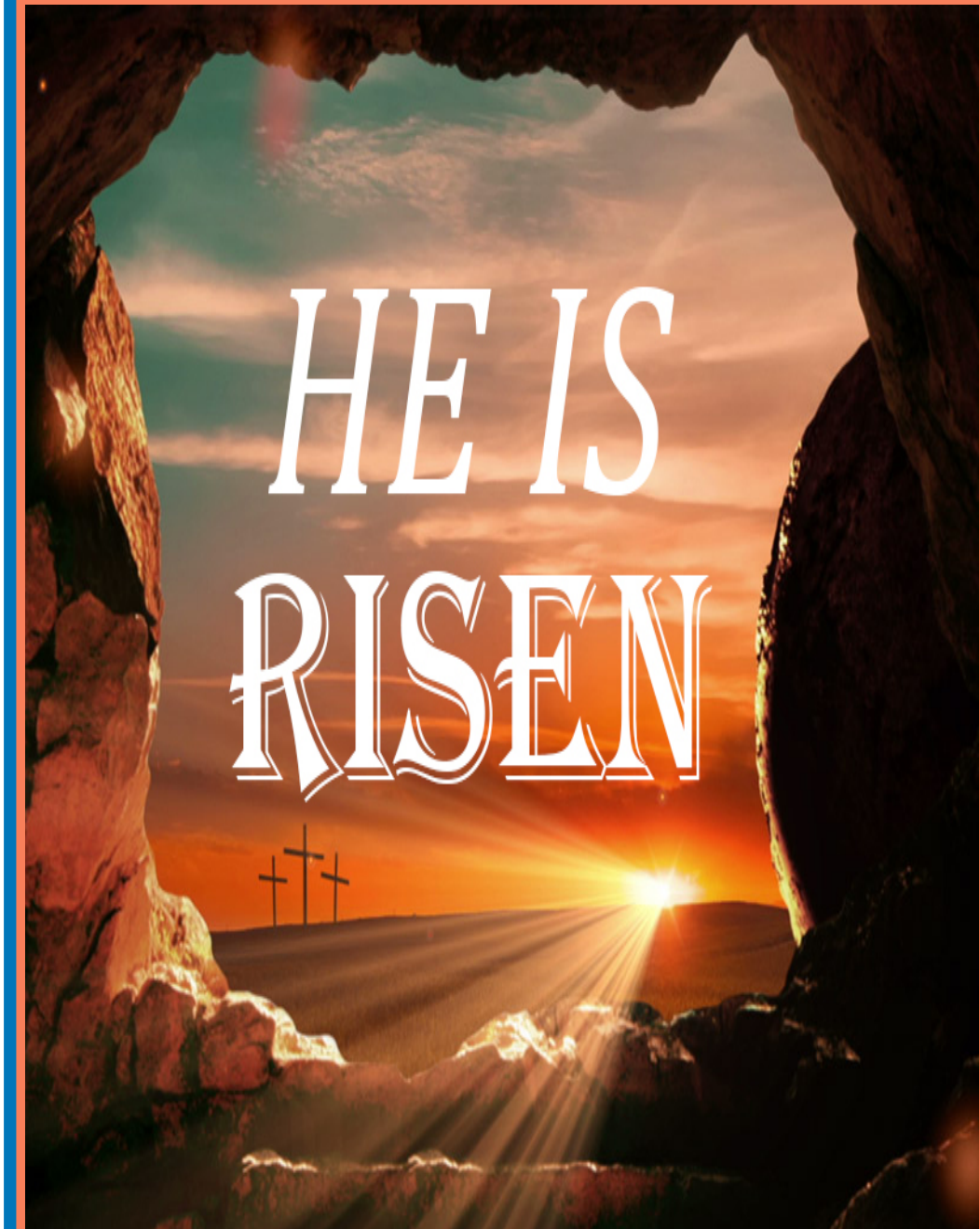
