cause my cup has overflowed.

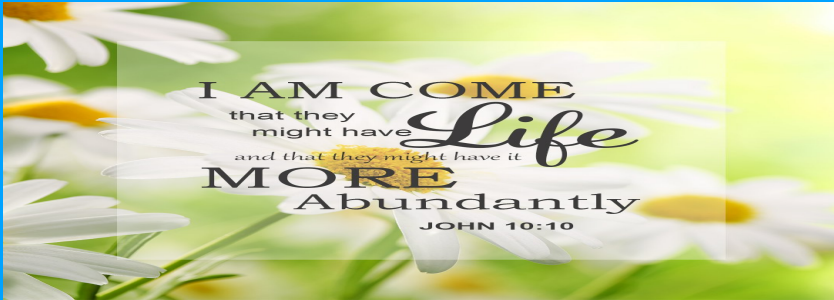
