Whene'er Dad looks at him.

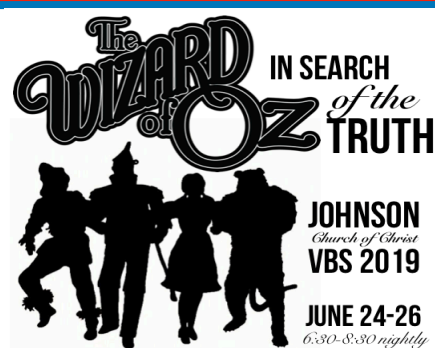
Dad is the hero of his dreams,
