CHALLENGE EVENTS

Challenge events are mean to be a personal hands on challenge to gain experience in different areas.

Scripture Challenge: To promote the habit of memorizing a large number of scripture. (25-100 verses)

Daily Devotional Challenge: Develops the habit of daily Bible Reading & prayer from 21-60 days or 10-15 minutes a day for 3 months.

Evangelism Challenge: To help teens reach out to others around them with God's word. (7-12th grade)

Leadership Challenge: Train those older in LTC to lead young participants in different events.(9-12th grade)

Service Challenge: Encourages students to make service part of their lifestyle.

Teaching Challenge: Encourages students to develop teaching skills. (3-12th grade) 2-4 weeks in a class.

Worship Challenge: help young men learn to participate in worship. (3-12th grade boys)
