WHAT WAS THAT AGAIN, AMOS?

What business did Amos have preaching? He even confessed, "I was no prophet, neither was I a prophet's son." Yet here he was -upbraiding the people for all they were worth. He had a sense of mission that would not be stifled.

Was it right for the rich to sit around oppressing the poor and crushing the needy? Amos didn't think so. It was a time of great prosperity, and most folks were living it up. They were so bent on their own pleasures that their ears were closed to the crisis of the needy. So Amos shouted:

"Woe to those who lie upon beds of ivory, and stretch themselves upon their couches, and eat lambs from the flock. and calves from the midst of the stall: who sing idle songs to the sound of the harp, and like David invent for themselves instruments of music; who drink wine in bowls. and anoint themselves with the finest oils. but are not grieved over the ruin of Joseph"! (Amos 6:4-6)

It was time for justice and righteousness. But if they failed in this hour, then the hands of the clock were pointed to judgement. "Prepare to meet your God, O' Israel."

True religion involves more than just an hour or so a week in worship. It takes into account the needs of all men. If you listen carefully you can still hear the words of Amos: "But let justice roll down like water and righteousness like an ever-flowing stream."
