Why This Punishment

Isaiah predicted that the disfigurement and suffering of the Servant would be viewed as a punishment from God. "Surely he hath borne our griefs and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God and afflicted." What else man reasons could possibility account for the rejection, contempt, sorrow and grief, unless this is an open declaration that God will not have him. Surely he must be suffering a well-deserved punishment from God.

Men through the ages have viewed unusual suffering as a mark of divine displeasure. The Jews were convinced that this was true of Galileans, whose blood Pilate had mingled with their sacrifices. And they reasoned that those eighteen on whom the tower in Siloam fell, must have been sinners above all men that dwelt at Jerusalem (Luke 13:1-4). Eliphaz the Temanite stated this philosophy succinctly to Job when he said:

"Remember, I pray thee, who ever perished, being innocent? Or where were the righteous cut off? Even as I have seen, they that plow iniquity and sow wickedness, reap the same. By the blast of God they perish, and by the breath of his nostrils are they consumed" (Job 4:7-9).

And when Paul was bitten by a snake on the isle of Melita, those present thought that undoubtedly he was a murder whom, "though he hath escaped the sea, yet vengeance sufferers not to live" (Acts 28:4). Thus the Jews who had already pronounced Jesus "guilty of death" (Matthew 26:66), one did not have to search for an explanation of the sufferings of Jesus. He was being punished by God.

But the supposed cause of our Lord's suffering and the real reason for it were altogether different. What the prophet would have us to understand is that the Servant took these sufferings which were ours, and which we deserved to bear, upon himself as though they were his own. He paid the price of sin for us. And now we can have "peace" because the barriers between God and ourselves have been removed. "Surely he hath borne our griefs and carried our sorrows...But he was wounded for our transgression, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed."

When Jesus died on the cross, He was not being punished by God but suffering that we might be spared. Oh what a glorious thought!




