Interruptions

I've watched church secretaries for years, and I will never understand how they ever get their work done. It's one interruption right after another all day long. I so admire Stefanie at how she handles, with such kindness, the many interruptions in her day. I've known preachers who would hide out a day or two each week just so they could prepare for their class and sermons. Others have resorted to very early mornings or late night hours so their concentration will not be broken by an unexpected guest or phone call.

If we are not careful, interruptions can annoy us. We may even be following the path of the lady who said, "Don't interrupt me while I am interrupting."

One of the things that really impresses me about Jesus is how patient he was in the midst of interruptions. He was interrupted while speaking (Matthew 9:18), and even when he was in a prayer (Mark 1:35-39). As he went about preaching, he was interrupted by a leper who sought healing (Mark 1:40). In Capernaum a paralytic was let down the roof above Jesus while our Lord was in the middle of a sermon (Mark 2:1-12). When he was on his way to Jerusalem to die, a blind beggar cried out to him. The crowd shouted their disapproval, but Jesus stopped and gave the man his sight (Mark 10:46-50). One comes away with the feeling that the life of our Lord was just one interruption right after another, but none of these seemed to bother him. May God grant us this sensitivity and repose!

A teacher once remarked, "You know, my whole life I have been complaining that my work was constantly interrupted, until I discovered that my interruptions were my work." I feel the same way. I want you to know that you are never an interruption, and you can call or come by to see me at any time.


