In speaking of the idols which were so common in his day, Jeremiah says, "Their idols are like scarecrows in a cucumber field, and they cannot speak; they have to be carried for they cannot walk." (Jeremiah 10:5) That sounds like a helpless god. They can't speak and they have to be carried because they can't walk.

There are many people today whose God is a burden to them. He is just one more added responsibility, and one more obligation. They worshipeven though they hate the thought. They give - even though it pains them. They keep commands-even though they had just as soon take castor oil. Their God is plainly a burden to them. 
